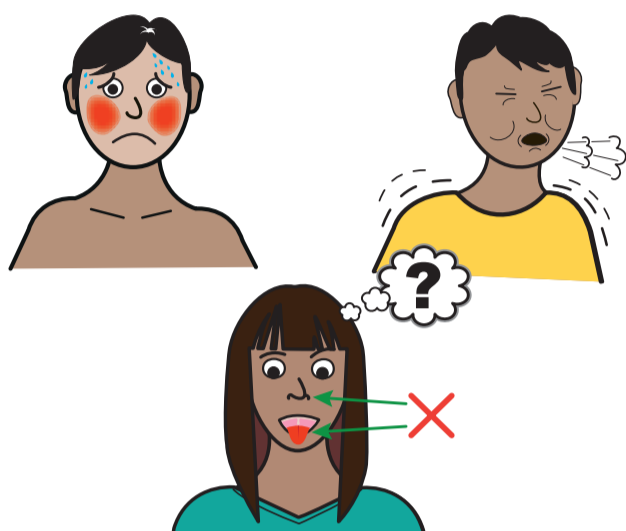


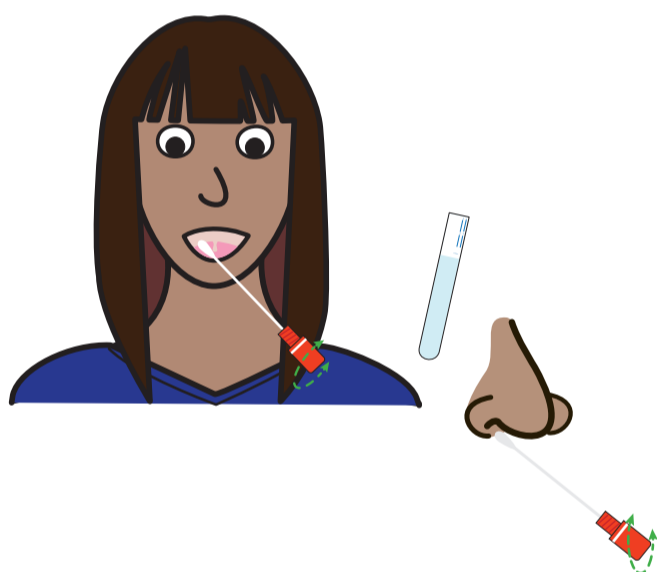
Testing for Coronavirus COVID-19

If you or someone you live with becomes poorly you may test for Coronavirus.



You should have a test if you have

- A **high temperature**
- A **new dry cough**
- Lots of new **coughing** for more than one hour.
- **3** or more **new coughs** in a day.
- A **change or loss** of what you can **taste or smell**.



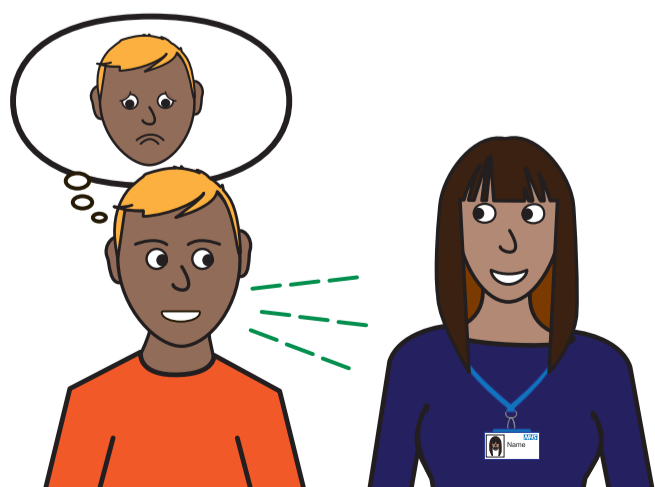
The test is done using a cotton bud called a swab

- First they will wipe a swab at the **back of your throat**.
- They will then wipe a swab around the **inside of the end of your nose**.



The test is not nice, but it will **not hurt** and will not take long.

The **swab** will then be sent away to be **tested**.



Stay at home until you get your results.

You will get the result in about **2 days**.

If you have Coronavirus you need to **isolate at home for 14 days**.

If you don't have Coronavirus you don't need to isolate at home.
