


Learning Disability Services

The team are working to ensure quality and uptake of the annual health check for people with learning disabilities




We offer free accessible information to support a person with a learning disability, family and support teams understanding about the annual health check




We provide free training to non-learning disability professionals who are caring or supporting a person with a learning disability in their service.

This may include Doctors practices, mental health of health screening services.

We support the education of health care students through classroom teaching and health care placements within the team. Encouraging non-specific Learning disability field students to attend, learning about supporting a person with a learning disabilities within their field of practice




Improving communication between service users and health professionals. The team work closely with service users, utilising co-production, inclusion, training sessions and feedback.
