- we take time to understand the problem and co-design solutions

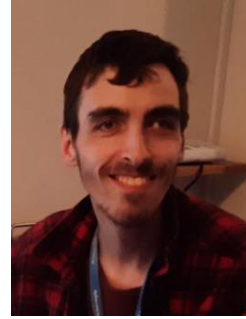

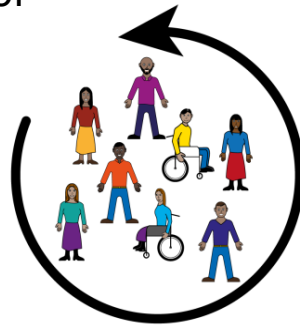
