


## Shingles Did you know?



Shingles is a virus that causes a painful rash on your body.


If you have Shingles you can feel very poorly.



You might feel poorly first and then a rash will appear later.

You can not catch Shingles. You can only get Shingles if you have had Chicken Pox.

Not everyone who has had Chicken Pox will get Shingles.



The Shingles rash is red, painful and can itch or sting.

The rash can be on any part of your body but will only be on one side.



If you have a rash on both sides of your body this is not Shingles.

If you have Shingles you will get liquid filled spots on your body.




If you have Shingles you may find it hard to sleep.



You may not feel hungry.



You might have a painful headache and feel unwell.



Shingles can make you poorly for many weeks.

You can get Shingles more than once.



Shingles may cause pain even after the rash has gone.

This pain may last for a long time.



If you are between 70 and 79 years old you can have a vaccination to stop you getting as poorly.

You can have the vaccination even if you have had Shingles before.



You should speak to your doctor if you would like to have the vaccination.
