


Question:

Answer:


You might have a **headache** or feel like you are getting a cold.

This is your **body** learning how to **fight** Covid-19, you should feel better after about 2 days.



Question: Will the Covid jab hurt?





Answer:

The injection may feel like a **scratch**.

Some people have a painful **arm** for a few days afterwards.



Question:

Where can I get my Covid jab?







Answer:

There are **lots** of places to get the Covid jab.


You can phone **119** to find a place.



Question:

I've had a Covid jab, do I need another one?






Answer:


Yes, you will need a **booster** jab of the Covid vaccine **every year**.



Question:

If I get the vaccine, can I still get Covid-19?





Answer:

You **can** still get Covid-19 **after** the jab.


But you will get **less** poorly than if you didn't have the jab.



Question:

When I get my Covid jab can I use my wheelchair?





Answer:

When you **book** your Covid jab, tell the person that you use a **wheelchair**.

They will make sure you **can** get in the building.



Question:

Will I be able to get reasonable adjustments when I get my Covid jab?





Answer:

Yes, you can ask for reasonable adjustments when you book your Covid jab.
