CARERS CORNER

If you are an unpaid carer you may benefit from information and advice on getting the best support for you and the person you care for.

Carers Corner has guidance on where to go for support, what's available locally as well as information on your legal rights and entitlements.



What is an unpaid carer?

An unpaid carer is anyone who looks after a family member, partner or friend who needs help because they are ill, frail, have a disability, mental health problem or an addiction and cannot cope without their support. The care they give is unpaid which means you are not caring as a professional (community care worker, residential care worker or a nurse).
