


# Long-Covid project

Things I like to do outside of work:


I enjoy playing football and spending time with family.

- Designing images to help explain health.




# Sharing information and ideas – Training new staff.



In January Dom and Holly gave some training to new staff.




Dom talked about a bad experience when he didn't get reasonable adjustments in an appointment.







