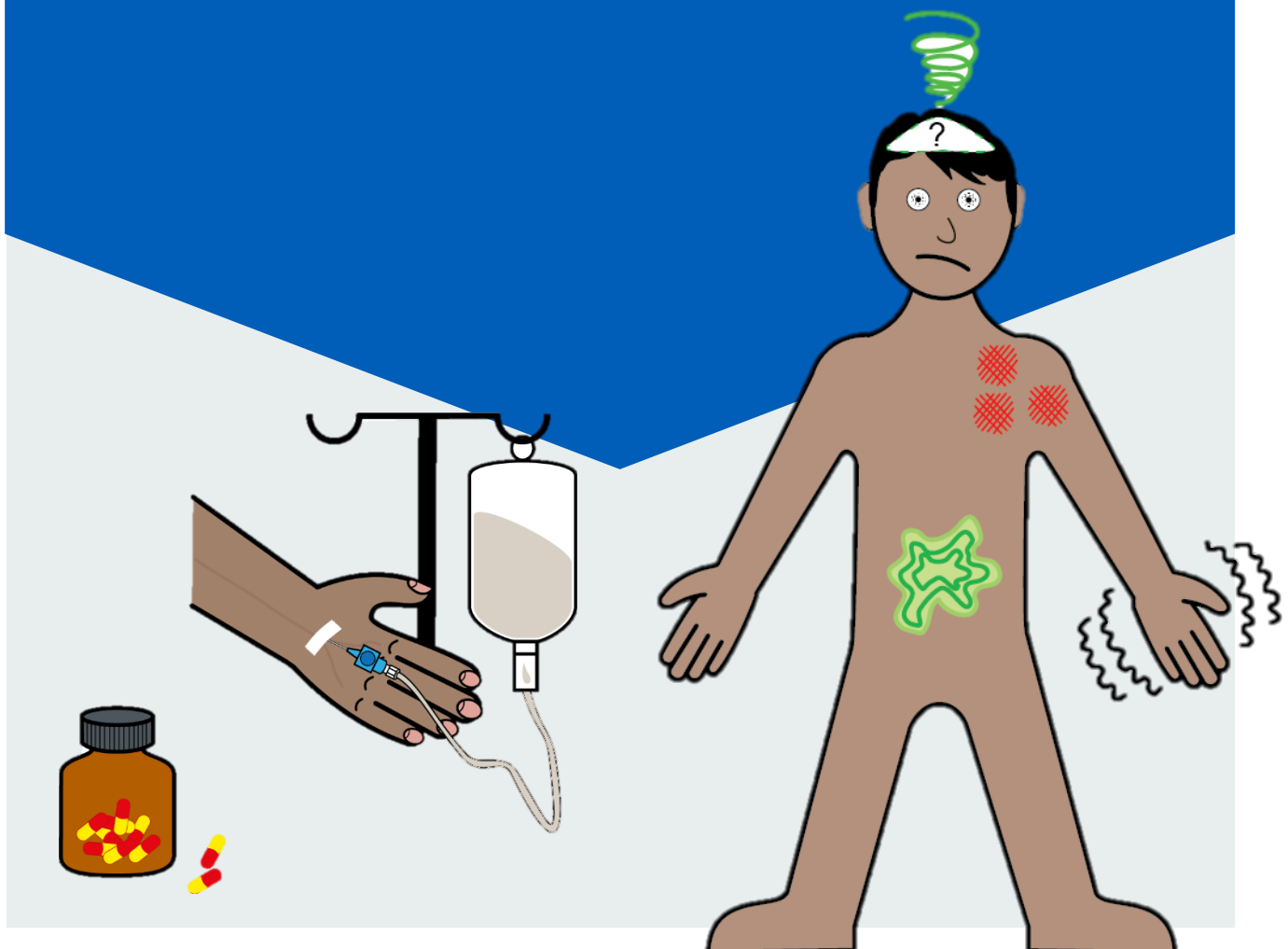
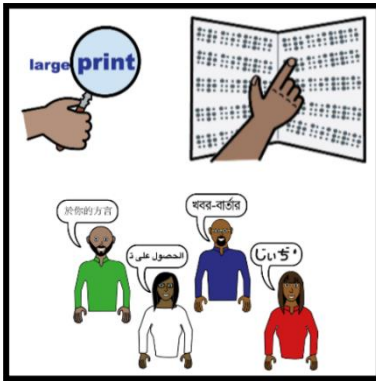

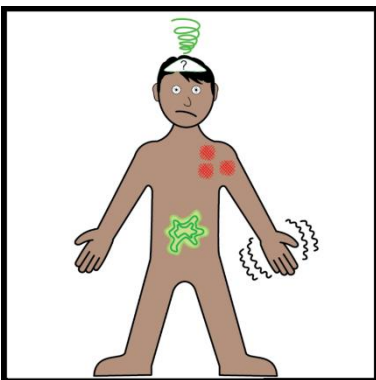

Your doctor has given you some antibiotics to help you get better.

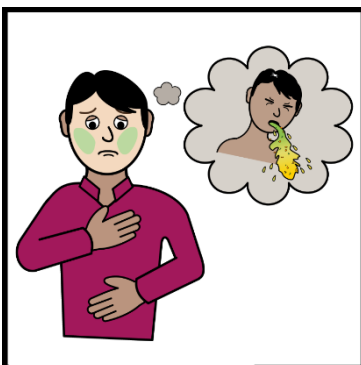


This leaflet will tell you about possible side effects. Some people don't get any. Some people do.

- Feeling sick, this can also be called nausea



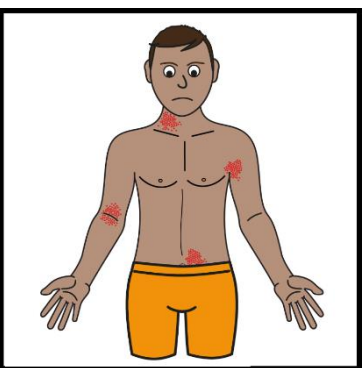
- Diarrhoea



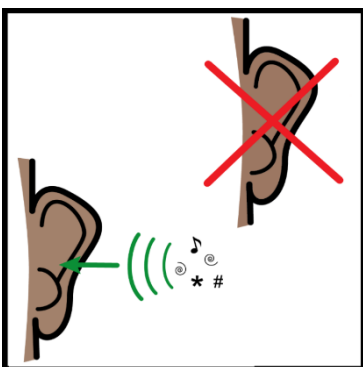
- Headaches



- Dizziness

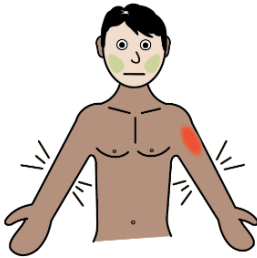


- A rash anywhere on your body



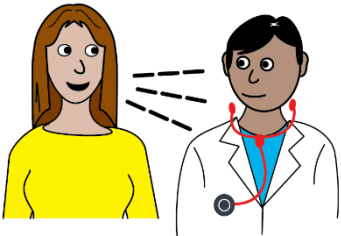

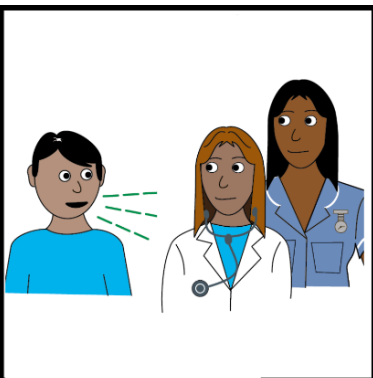
