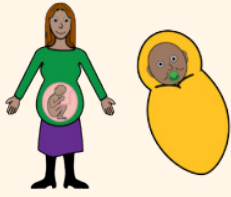


Screening Timeline

Birth

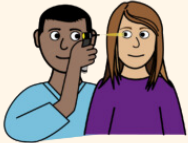


Babies

When somebody is **pregnant** they will be offered screening tests to check the health of the unborn baby.

When the **baby** is born they will have physical tests, hearing tests and also a small blood test.

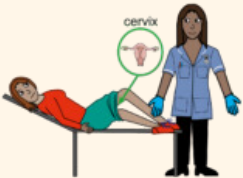


Diabetic eye screening

From the age of 12 everyone with **diabetes** is offered regular eye screening.

This test looks for the signs of diabetic retinopathy. This is damage in your retina.

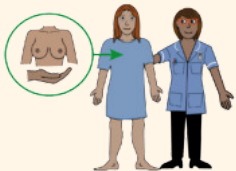


Cervical Screening

From the age of 25 to 64, **everyone with a cervix** can have their cervical screening test. They are every 3-5 years. You will get an invitation in the post. Transgender men can ask to have one.

This looks for changes in your cells in your cervix that could lead to cervical cancer.

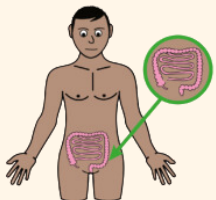


Breast Screening

From the age of 50 to 71, all **women** will be invited to have breast screening every 3 years. Transgender men can ask to have one.

This looks for signs of breast cancer by taking an x-ray image of the inside of your breast

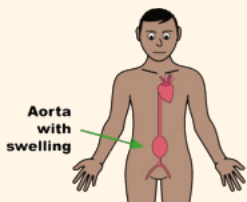


Bowel screening

From the age of 50 **everyone** will get a bowel cancer screening test in the post every 2 years.

For this you send off a poo sample. This checks for signs of bowel cancer.































AAA Screening

From the age of 65 **all men** are invited to AAA screening. Trans women can ask to have one. You only need it once.

This uses an ultrasound scan to look for signs of swelling in your aorta. This is the main blood vessel that takes blood from your heart to your tummy.
